## VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR TO BE FILLED BY CO-OPTION

**Fivehead Parish Council will consider filling by co-option a casual vacancy for a Councillor at its meeting on Monday 1 August 2016 @1930 to be held at the Village Hall, Stowey Road, Fivehead**

Anyone interested in serving the community in this way and who wants to become a candidate for co-option should send the following details to the Clerk (email to [fiveheadpc@gmail.com](mailto:fiveheadpc@gmail.com) or mail to Spindlewood, Ganges Hill, Fivehead, TA3 6PF):

1. Full name and address (inc telephone number and email).
2. Confirmation that you will be at least 18 years old on 1 August 2016.
3. To confirm eligibility, please answer Yes or No to the following:
  - a) On the current electoral register for the Parish/Ward
  - b) Have lived in the parish or within 3 miles/4.8kms of the parish boundary (as the crow flies) for at least 12 months
  - c) Main place of business is based in the parish
  - d) Own property within the parish
4. Confirm that you not aware of any disqualification to you serving as a Councillor. You would be disqualified if you are subject to a bankruptcy Restriction Order, or have been convicted of a criminal offence with imprisonment for 3 months or more, including suspended, within the last 5 years.
5. Explain in no more than 100 words why you would like to join the Parish Council.

Please note: If successful, you will be required to complete an entry in the Parish Council's Register of Members' interests. This involves putting your address, employment, relevant major shareholdings and membership of charities, pressure groups, political parties, etc, on public record.

Completed applications should be returned to the Clerk by **Friday 22 July 2016**.

Information on the role of the Parish Council and its schedule of meetings may be obtained from the Clerk.
