

**SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(A378 LANGPORT ROAD AND TOP ROAD) (FIVEHEAD)**  
**(REVOCAION AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)**  
**ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order in exercise of its powers under Sections 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, the effect of which is to introduce a 30 mph speed limit on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

A copy of the draft Order, the plan showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the order may be inspected during normal office hours at Somerset County Council, A Block Reception, County Hall, Taunton, TA1 4DY or online at [www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO](http://www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO)

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order may do so in writing, specifying the grounds on which it is made, to Somerset County Council, Traffic Management, B2 West, County Hall, Taunton, TA1 4DY, quoting reference No. KT27032018 and received no later than the 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2018.

The names and addresses of anyone writing in may be made available for public inspection and will be included in a report that may be published on the Somerset County Council website, unless the individuals concerned state, in writing, their objection to their names and addresses being made so available or being included in the publication.

**SCHEDULE 1**  
**30 mph Speed Limit**

A378 – Langport Road Fivehead	From a point 119 metres west of the centre of its junction with Top Road for a distance of approximately 1485 metres in an easterly then north easterly direction.
Top Road Fivehead	From the centre of its junction with the A378 Langport Road for a distance of approximately 60 metres in a south westerly direction.

**SCHEDULE 2**  
**Revocation of 40 mph Speed Limit**

A378 – Langport Road  
Fivehead

From a point 60 metres east of the centre of its junction with Top Road for a distance of approximately 1222 metres in an easterly then north easterly direction.
